Lives of the Saints – D-Day, new pastor

6 June 1944: “The radio was on all day about the war news & the invasion is on.” *11 June:* “Left here at 15 to 3. Doris walked down with me till Opal overtook us at Gartleys . . . Mr [Gordon] Smith had his first service in this church today & took as his text Teach us to pray, part of the 1st verse of the 11th chapter of Luke. Had a good crowd to hear him too, around 30 I think. . . . Mr Smith had a special Litany for the War & we ans ‘We beseech thee to hear us, Good Lord’.”
