Lives of the Saints – *red hangings*

10 October 1948: "Hazel shewed us the new cover for the Communion table – cost \$150.00. [W]ilbert is giving it in memory of Uncle Ben & Aunt Jane & they will have it dedicated when the Bishop is here for Confirmation."

31 October: "Stopped at Bobbys & got a ride down with Wendell & Anna. A big crowd there to hear the Bishop & he certainly gave a good sermon & left lots for people to think on. Took his text from Matt 9th chapter & part of the 9th verse -- & he saith unto him "Follow me" & he arose & followed him, etc. He dedicated the new altar cloth first, in memory of Uncle Ben & Aunt Jane & then Mr [Gordon] Smith had 6 to be confirmed: Paul & Mary Bell from here, 2 from Kirkland & 2 from Richmond – 3 boys & 3 girls. They had a good choir & sang 4 hymns. Eva & Katie were there in the choir with Mabel & Anna. Wendell, Bobby & Charlie at the other side.

Guess the church was quite well filled up today. They sang 605: Rejoice the Lord is King 579: O Jesus I have promised & 621: Take my Life etc.”
